HEAT TREATMENT OF MOVING TRUCK

PREPARATION CHECKLIST

For a successful treatment, please follow these instructions to prepare moving truck for treatment.

1. Clean any items that may have come in contact with pesticides with soap and water before placing them in the truck. **Contact us if you used pesticides less than 3 weeks ago.**
2. Ensure that you rent a truck according to your home size, so that there will be adequate space for all your belongings and our equipment
3. Arrange items the same as for a regular move. Leaving 3 to 4 feet of space at the end for our equipment.
4. All clothing can remain packed in boxes or bags up to 80% filled, leaving some room for air circulation, no vacuum packed bags.
5. All electronics/appliances can remain, no need to remove.
6. Remove all items that should not be heated or that you are not sure can be heated. Please place these items in a box marked **DO NOT HEAT** and in the truck last so that on our inspection we can find them first.
Examples: plants, antiques, vinyl blinds, vinyl records, oil paintings, certain musical instruments, expensive alcoholic beverages, carbonated beverages, cosmetics, crayons, aerosol cans, pressurized cans, hairsprays, spray on deodorants, spray paints and aerosol cleaning products. Anything that can explode or change consistency/quality if heated.
7. Secure all loose papers/documents. Books can be treated, make sure they are in a secure place.
8. **Remove any firearms and ammunition.**
9. Remove all drugs, medications (prescription or not)
10. After the heat treatment is complete, it is very important to change the clothes that you wore for the day before entering the new unit. Ensure to wash and dry the used clothes as soon as possible.
